as improved customer satisfaction and increased revenue. But at the same time, you're still accountable for increasing IT efficiency and keeping costs down.

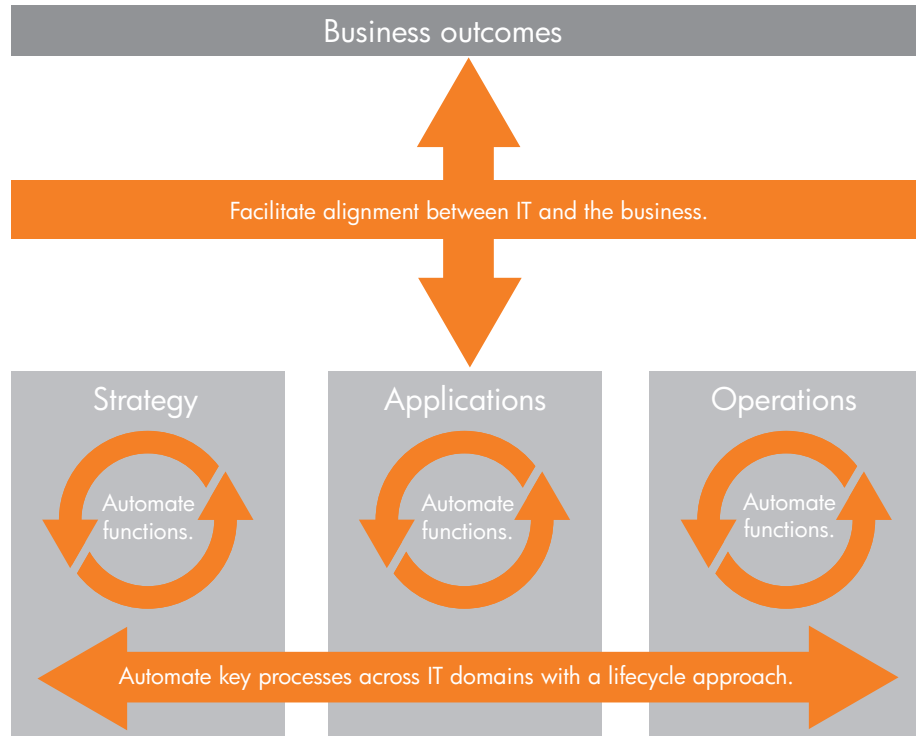

What is BTO?

BTO is an approach to IT management and a category of software and services supporting that approach. It is based on three key principles:

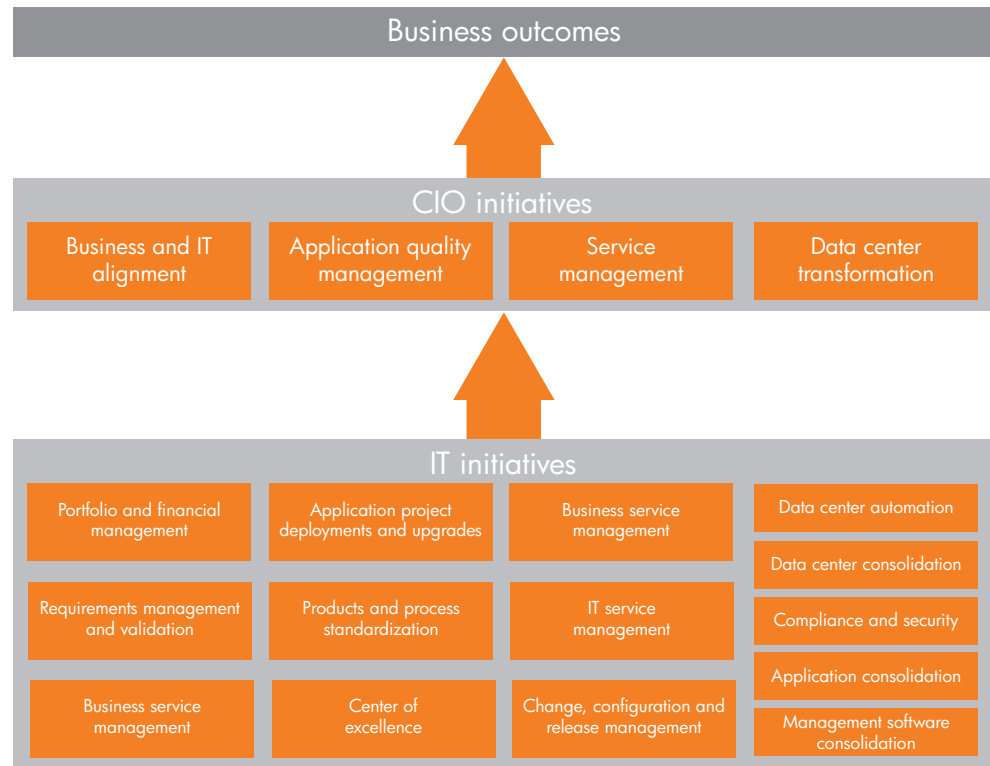
